UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

Mike Pompeo (Cal. No. 1)

Ordered, That following Leader remarks on Monday, January 23, 2017, the Senate proceed to executive session to resume consideration of the nomination of Mike Pompeo, of Kansas, to be Director of the Central Intelligence Agency, and there be six hours of debate on the nomination, equally divided in the usual form, and that following the use or yielding back of time, the Senate vote on the nomination with no intervening action or debate; that if confirmed, the motion to reconsider be considered made and laid upon the table; the President be immediately notified of the Senate's actions and that no further motions be in order to the nomination.
